

Stormy weather leads to morning power outages, ferry cancellations

At one point, about 24,000 Lower Mainland customers were without power

LOWER MAINLAND (NEWS1130) – Blustery weather has knocked out power for thousands around BC today.

At one point this morning, 35,000 BC Hydro customers were without power, including about 24,000 in the Lower Mainland and on the Sunshine Coast.

[Several ferry sailings were put on hold](#) this morning, but service has resumed.

“There is another storm predicted to come in tonight. So, [we're watching] the timing of it — whether it will be after our operational day or before. That’s something we’re going to closely monitor for the rest of the day,” says Deborah Marshall with BC Ferries.

She says weather could also be an issue tomorrow.
